3. One-Stop Operator Report

Employ Milwaukee has contracted with Maximus to serve as the One-Stop Operator (OSO) of Job Centers in WDA 2 (One Stops = Job Centers). Some of the OSO responsibilities include:

- Ensure access to Job Center partner programs and services
- Assist with development of Job Center MOUs and certifications
- Coordinate Job Center and outreach activities with Employ Milwaukee
- o Coordinate meetings and action plans of WDA 2's Job Center Management Team
- Establish single points of entry (electronic and physical) for job seekers and employers

Maximus' comprehensive location is Job Center Central. There are three affiliate locations: Milwaukee's Walker's Square Job Center (America Works), YWCA SE Wisconsin Job Center, and Milwaukee SE Job Center (UMOS).

Laura Bray presented on Title II administered by MATC's School of Pre-College Education. The program serves 750 students by helping them earn measurable skills (GED, HSED) and attain secondary/postsecondary credential.

Jobs for Veterans State Grant (JVSG)

Al Garcia with Office of Veteran's Services presented. JVSG is a WIOA State Combined Plan Program in Wisconsin that is administered by Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development, Division of Employment and Training, Office of Veterans Employment, with the mission of advancing veterans into the workforce through targeted business engagement and effective employment services. The vision is to establish networks with employers who understand the value of Veterans and are committed to hiring those who have served our nation and with Veterans who are prepared to enter the workforce. Three legs of support are utilized to support veterans at our Job Centers and approach is having a 35% success rate.

i. Disabled Veterans Outreach Program (DVOP) specialist – serves veterans needing intensive services

- ii. Local Veterans Employment Representatives (LVERs) work with employers to promote the benefits of hiring veterans
- iii. Job Center Staff Ensure priority of service to all veterans
