employment with healthcare employers and two (2) completed their HSED. Standards of Excellence in Education is the training provider for this program. The next Construction Plus – Healthcare cohort of 12-14 participants will start on 11/7/2022. The Construction training track for YouthBuild is actively recruiting participants for a November 12th start date.

Brighter Futures is an in-school youth program that complements WIOA In School Youth (ISY). The program's service provider, Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Milwaukee (BGCGM), is not meeting its contractual goals. Staff meets weekly with the Boys and Girls Club to discuss ways to improve their performance.

4. Youth Committee Member Updates

Gerard Randall thanked the Milwaukee Public Schools and all committee members for hosting the Historic Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) college fair as they were able to serve 700 families.
