Supportive services available through this program include:

Referrals to community programs & services	Referrals to state & federal public assistance programs
Fees for pre-employment or pre-training drug testing, background checks, & medical exams	Work-related required items
License & certification exam fees, including retake fees	Uniforms, work attire, & work-related equipment & tools
Transportation	Childcare & dependent care assistance
Job Readiness Training or other job coaching fees when other funding sources have been exhausted	Housing
Other items related to transportation, childcare, housing, testing, accommodations or other needs-related payments, may be considered on a case-by-case basis, & with the approval of EMI’s President/CEO.	

- Exceptions to the amounts and duration of supportive services may be made on a case-by-case basis with approval by EMI’s President/CEO.
