I. Background and Overview of RFP

C. Available Funding and Performance Period

WIOA funding for this solicitation is categorized by the two job seeker populations: Adult and Dislocated Workers. EMI anticipates reserving approximately \$700,000* in Adult and \$440,000* in Dislocated Worker funding for grants made under this solicitation to serve 400 adults and 240 Dislocated Workers. Respondents will be asked to provide both Adult and Dislocated Worker service delivery. Budgets and proposal narratives should clearly describe the respondent's approach to ensuring both target populations receive quality service delivery, as well as a plan for adjusting target population focus to respond to differing economic conditions.

EMI anticipates funding grant agreements effective July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2027. EMI reserves the right to renew grant agreements for up to three (3) additional one-year periods based on the service provider's achievement of benchmarks, funding availability, ability to leverage funds, compliance with WIOA, and the renewal's conformity with EMI's vision for the Milwaukee County public workforce system.

Additional funds received by EMI may be disbursed by expanding existing programs or by consideration of proposals not initially funded under this RFP and at the discretion of the EMI Board of Directors.

**Funding amounts are contingent upon the award received from Wisconsin DWD. Actual amounts may vary.*

V. Proposal Review and Evaluation Process

J. Disallowed Costs and Cancellations

Successful bidders must accept liability for all aspects of any WIOA program conducted under contract with EMI. Successful bidders will be liable for any disallowed costs or illegal expenditure of funds or program operations conducted. EMI reserves the right to cancel an award immediately if new

state or federal regulations or policy makes it necessary to change the program purpose or content substantially, or to prohibit such a program. Bidders must accept liability for all aspects of any WIOA program conducted under contract with EMI.

Profit Prohibition:

While federal regulations may permit profit under certain WIOA arrangements, Employ Milwaukee has determined that profit is not allowable under this solicitation. All contracts awarded under this RFP will be cost reimbursement only, and no contractor may earn or retain profit from WIOA Title I funds.

For-profit subrecipients are subject to 2 CFR part 200 and DOL's exceptions at 2 CFR part 2900; **no fee or profit is allowable** on WIOA Title I funds. Indirect costs are reimbursable only per an approved NICRA or de minimis 15% MTDC if eligible."
