



Funding Attestation and Moving Expense Reimbursement Federal Income Tax Information for Participants - Talent Recruitment Grant

Congratulations on your relocation to the City of Milwaukee through the Wisconsin Talent Recruitment Grant! As part of this program, you may receive reimbursement of eligible moving expenses if you meet all program requirements. Because these payments may be considered taxable income under federal tax law, we are providing the following information so that you can plan accordingly.

Are These Payments Taxable? Yes. Under current federal tax law, reimbursements for moving expenses are generally considered taxable income for individuals.

Because these reimbursements are not currently excluded from income under federal law, they are generally taxable. **The result of this double negative is that the reimbursements are generally included as taxable income.

IRS Reporting. As required under IRS reporting rules, Employ Milwaukee will issue you the appropriate IRS Form 1099 reporting the taxable payment you received during the calendar year.

You should retain this form with your tax records and provide it to your tax preparer when filing your federal and state income tax returns.

What This Means for You:

- The reimbursement is intended to help offset your relocation costs.
- The payment may increase your taxable income for the year.
- No federal or state income taxes will be withheld from the payment.
- You may wish to set aside a portion of the reimbursement to help cover any taxes due when you file your tax return.
- We cannot provide tax advice or determine your individual tax liability.
- If you have questions about how this payment affects your personal tax situation, please consult a qualified tax professional or the Internal Revenue Service.
