


Workforce Map

Competition from online job postings is high in Milwaukee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 220* job postings/mo, while there are 420 here.




Supply Is Lower Than the National Average


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Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is Low




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Milwaukee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,481* racially diverse employees, while there are 2,380 here.




Gender Diversity

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.




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

Industry Age Breakdown




Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown




