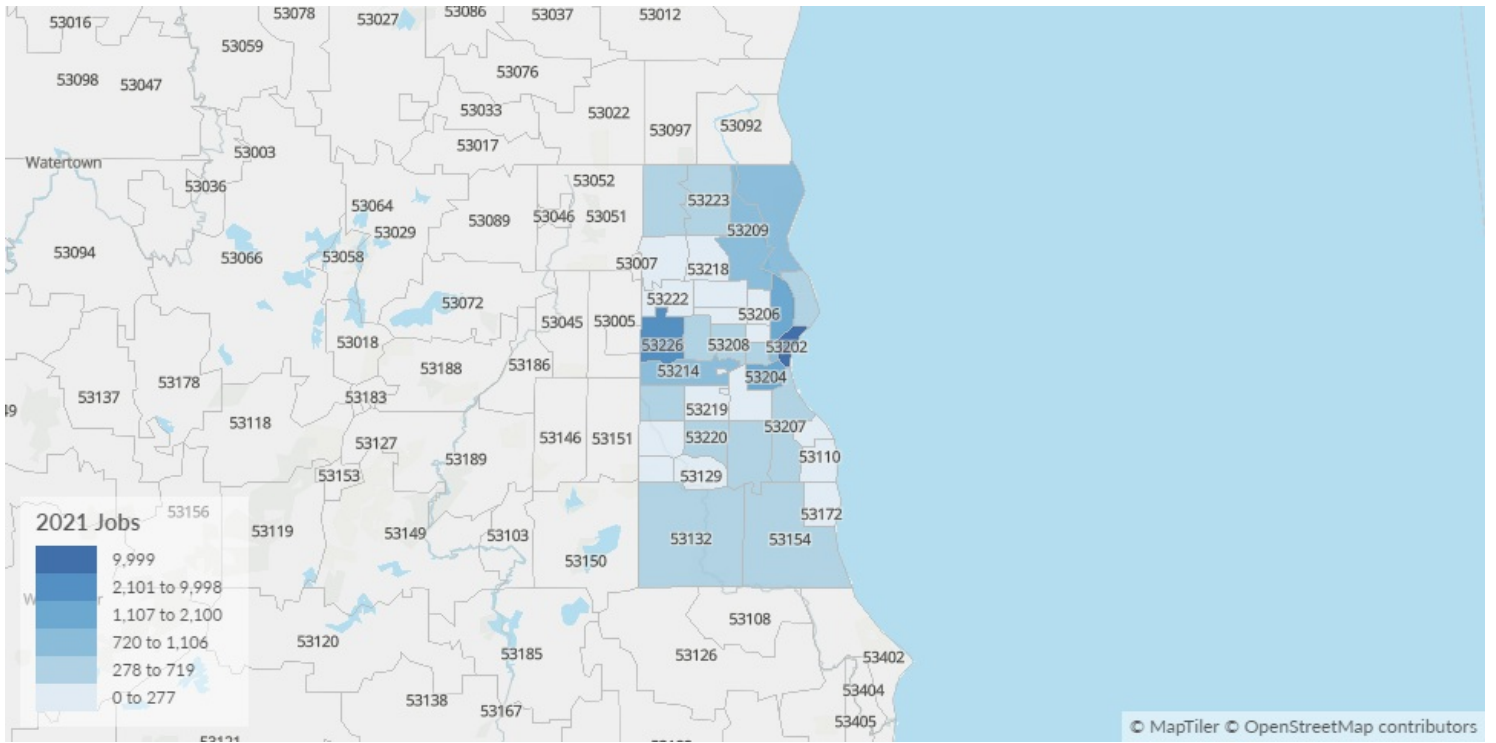

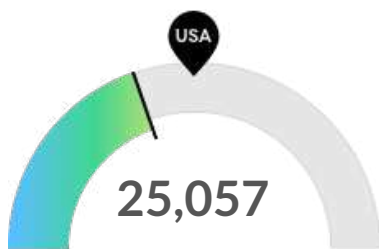

Aggressive Hiring Competition Over a Thin Supply of Regional Talent



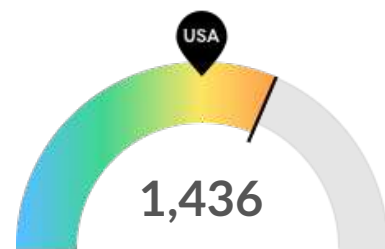
Supply (Jobs)

Milwaukee County, WI is not a hotspot for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 34,733* employees, while there are 25,057 here.



Earnings Per Job

Earnings per job are below the national average. The national average salary for Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services in an area this size is \$118,407, while in Milwaukee County, WI it is \$103,833. Earnings per jobs is the total industry earnings divided by the number of jobs in the industry.



Demand (Job Postings)

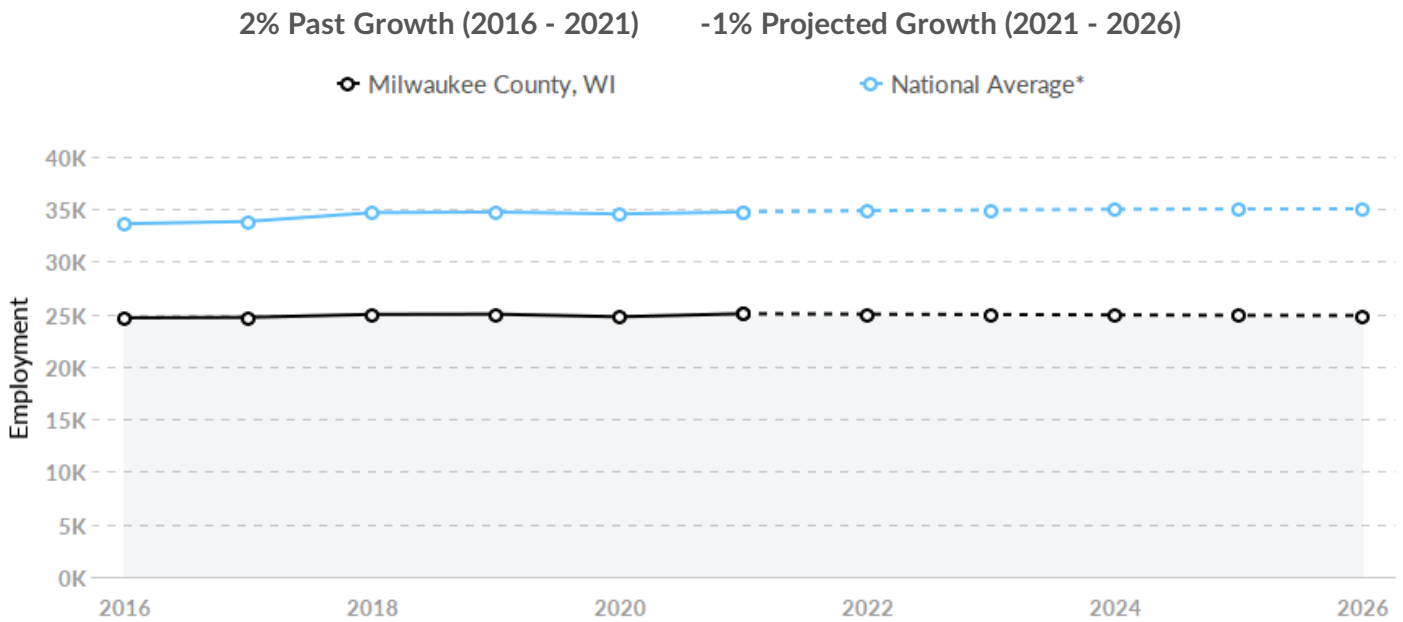
Competition from online job postings is high in Milwaukee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,001* job posting/mo, while there is 1,436 here.

Supply (Jobs)

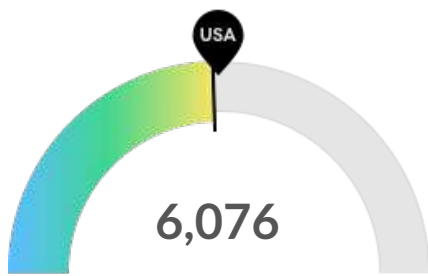
Supply Is Lower Than the National Average

The regional vs. national average employment helps you understand if the supply of Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services is a strength or weakness for Milwaukee County, WI, and how it is changing relative to the nation. 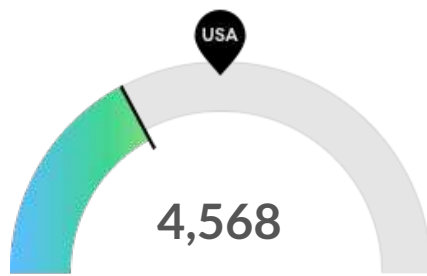

Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is Low



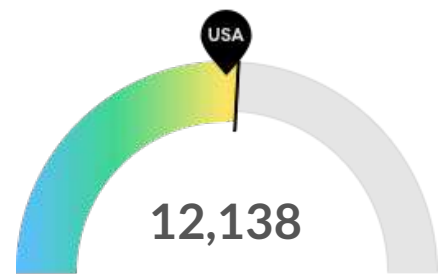
Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Milwaukee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,536* racially diverse employees, while there are 4,568 here.



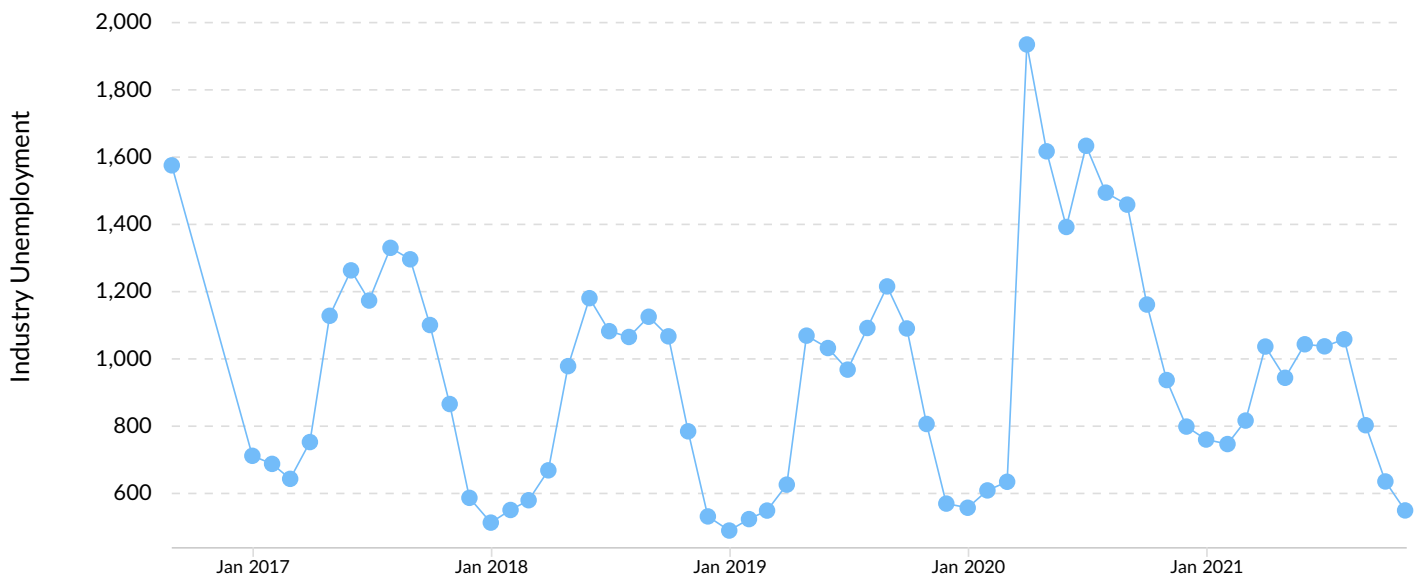
Gender Diversity

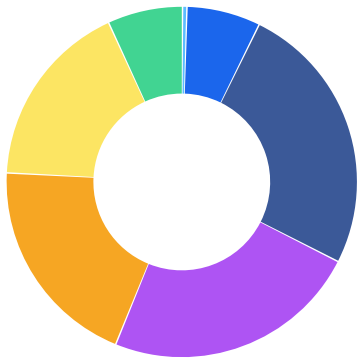
Unemployment Rate Trends

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.



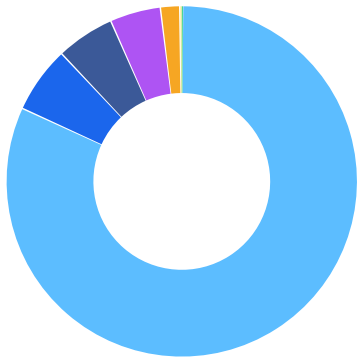

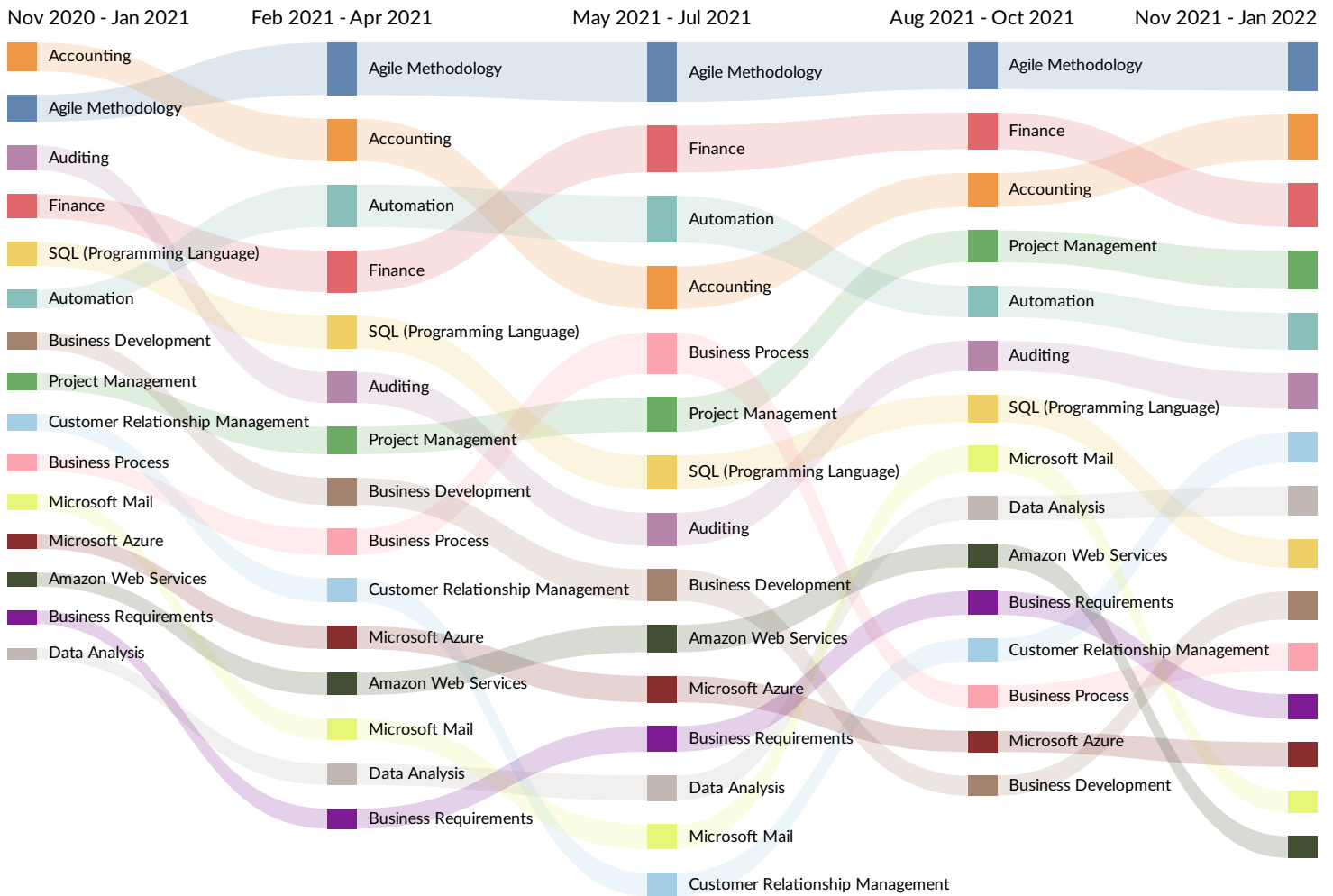

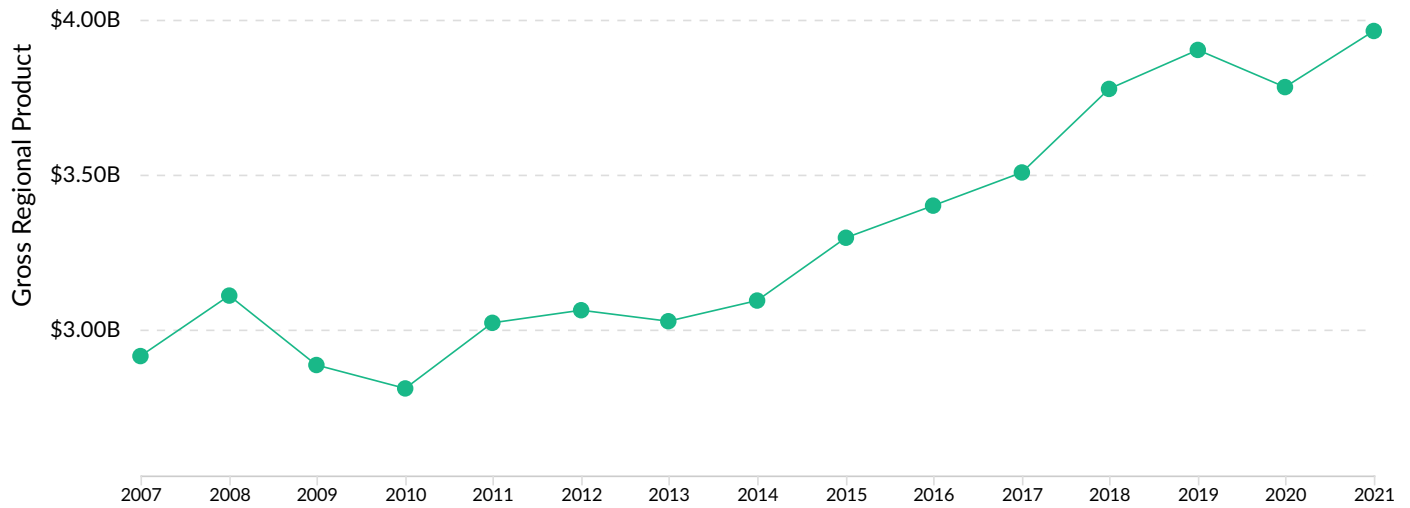
Top 15 Skills for All Job Types by Quarter
